About Jim Iacocca and his presentation:

Retired Brigadier General Jim Iacocca is the CEO of the Knox Regional Development Alliance (KRDA). The private-public non-profit organization is focused on protecting and promoting Fort Knox to increase its economic impact. The famed Army post celebrated its centennial last year. What for decades was the home of the Armor - the Army's tankers - is now a multi-faceted installation with a wide range of missions and a world class range and training complex. Jim will provide us with an update of the many missions on Fort Knox and what makes the installation such a valuable national defense asset. He will also share Fort Knox's economic impact on the region and how we can all play a part in ensuring the post continues to endure and grow.
