Official notice was sent recently via email to members about the increase of membership dues (additional \$21 annually), effective as of July 1, 2012. The last increase of membership dues occurred two years ago.

Rotary Meeting - June 21, 2012

It was a day to be glad I had brought a guest for her first visit to the Downtown Louisville Rotary Club. With a star studded head table and a program of community involvement, there were many guests present for a program that began with an appropriate prayer led by former President Paul Gold, "one of the best", followed by the Pledge and a rousing Rotary version of "The Battle Hymn of the Republic."

The parade of 'stars' began with the introduction of our newest member: Donna Hargens, Superintendent of the Jefferson County Public Schools, followed by Past President and Louisville Rotary Promise Scholarship Chair, Henry V. Heuser, Jr., also "one of the best", who introduced the Louisville Rotary Promise Scholarship Program and called on our Mayor, Greg Fischer, who thanked the Rotary Club for its leadership in addressing the community's need for a higher level of education for young people graduating from our school system before they enter the work force. He spoke of the goal set for 50,000 college degrees in Louisville by the year 2020, and then recognized the leadership of Dr. Tony Newberry, President of the Jefferson County Community and Technical College for his determination to help graduating high school seniors receive a college education.

Dr. Newberry, in turn, presented JCPS Superintendent Donna Hargens, who spoke of David Mike, the principal of Western High School, complimenting him for his impressive record in improving the level of training in that school, serving, as it does, a community of students who mostly come from homes without experience in programs of higher education. Further accolades for Western High School: since Mike has been Principal, there has been a 75% reduction in the number of suspensions and 400 students have been able to earn college credits for their work. The goal of the Louisville Promise Scholarship Program is that graduates of Western High School with a GPA of 2.5 or better, who want to get a college education will be able to attend JCTC for two years with a full scholarship, and then go on, after graduation, with a scholarship, to either the University of Louisville or the University of Kentucky, for a full four-year degree. The meeting concluded with Past President Heuser presenting two oversized checks—one for \$250,000 representing the fourth and most recent check given to the Jefferson County Community and Technical College; and another in the amount of \$1 million which represents the total amount given to date to JCTC, also representing the first of \$4 million which is the goal amount of the Louisville Rotary Promise Scholarship program, chaired by Henry V. Heuser, Jr. — David Reed

A subsequent workshop will develop the Action Plans to guide the day-to-day implementation of the board-approved Goals and Objectives. The full Strategic Plan will then be presented to the Board for approval.


