**About Theresa Reno-Weber**

Theresa Reno-Weber became the President & CEO of Metro United Way in 2017, its centennial year, and helped lead the organization to a record breaking \$36 Million 100th Anniversary Campaign.

In her presentation, "No Wrong Door," Theresa will talk about the doors she has walked through that took her from a small town in Connecticut, around the world and back again, only to land her in Louisville, KY. Also, hear about the work she is doing now at the Metro United Way to ensure that every door in our community is the right door for people seeking to better their lives and break the cycle of poverty.

## Walter Woods - March 7, 2019

Walter Woods, CEO of the Humana Foundation, related to Rotarians on a personal level to put the topic of giving in context. "Before I took this position, I thought the opposite of poverty was wealth. The opposite of poverty is not wealth; It's injustice," he shared. Walter explained that whereas the Humana Foundation is newly focused on upstream social determinants of health and well-being, helping to give people fair access to community resources. Shifting to a mindset of "fewer, bigger," and from a funding model to an investing model, Walter initiated the Strategic Community Investment Program, helping non-profits build and scale their solutions, particularly in focus areas of food security, social connection, asset security and post-secondary success. Starting at the \$500,000 level of grants, 175 proposals were received last year, and nine were selected in Louisville and 7 other communities across the southeast. The program has now grown to include more community organizations at smaller grant levels, and also disaster relief efforts, while maintaining an emphasis on investing in programs that improve equitable access to resources for healthy growth across communities.
