### About the Unsung Heroes Program:

Unsung Heroes reflects Rotary's focus on education, one of six areas of focus for this international service organization. Unsung Heroes honors outstanding high school students from 51 participating Louisville area high schools who exemplify Rotary's value of "Service Above Self." Many students have distinguished themselves by performing selfless community service out of the limelight - hence the name "Unsung Hero."

Each Unsung Hero receives a \$250 award, a package of gift certificates to an array of Louisville attractions and a commemorative certificate.

From the entire pool of Unsung Heroes finalists, ten students who plan to enroll at a local university are selected to receive a one-time \$500 scholarship. Five universities in Kentucky match the Unsung Heroes scholarships. In addition, thanks to the generosity of long-time Rotarian Theodore Buerck, the Rotary Fund of Louisville - the charitable arm of the Rotary Club of Louisville - awards a \$2000 scholarship to two

Unsung Heroes who plan to attend a local post-secondary institution.

### Theresa Reno-Weber - March 14, 2019

Theresa Reno-Weber, having taken the position as President & CEO of Metro United Way in 2017, related to Rotarians that being a recipient of United Way-supported services as a child gave her an appreciation and passion for community service leadership. As a child, identified early by a caring teacher as being reading-challenged, Theresa received dedicated help from a reading specialist, and then discovered The Girl Scouts of American which ignited a confidence that enabled and readied her for leadership positions in her future endeavors. Given her path and motivation to "pay it forward," Theresa applies personal drive behind the outcome-focused mission she sees for The United Way: "We fund outcomes that help people in the community thrive." Now responsible for the 30th largest United Way in the Country, with a \$36 million budget supporting agencies in seven counties, serving more than 250,000 people of extremely diverse needs, Theresa says that her current emphasis is to make delivery of services more efficient through the "United Community" effort which "removes barriers to access." She sees her current responsibilities as a culmination of life experiences involving individuals who cared enough to engage her in the community services she needed to pursue her path in life, and she is guiding the Metro United Way toward assurance of that support for all people of need in all served communities.
