**Lyle D. Roelofs** began his tenure as Berea College's ninth president on July 1, 2012. A graduate of Calvin College with a Bachelor of Science degree with honors in physics and mathematics, he earned M.S. and Ph.D. degrees, both in physics, at the University of Maryland.

In keeping with the celebratory theme of the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Rotary Club of Louisville, President Roelofs will focus his presentation on the unique and interesting history of Berea College's Great Commitments.

The Great Commitments serve as the College's mission statement and grow directly from its remarkable history and traditions. They are also the lens through which the College shares that history to the campus and the larger world through the notions of "love over hate, human dignity and equality, and peace with justice." Roelofs has devoted the first year of his presidency to advocating those ideals and values expressed in the Commitments along with the importance of Learning, Labor, and Service.




