About Moshe Ohayon:

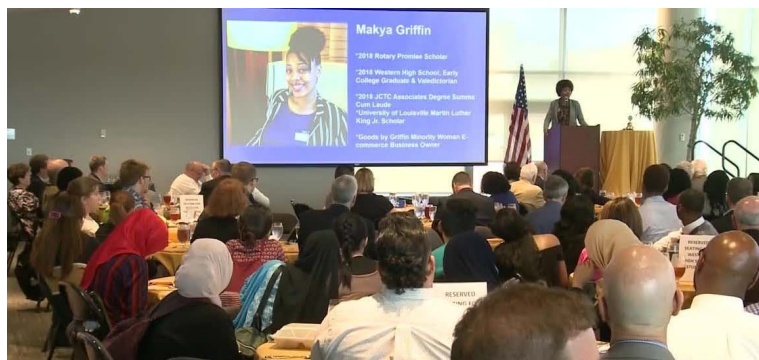
A crisis is raging in American education. Since 2013, children living in low-income homes make up the majority of our public school students, and the staggering income achievement gap continues to widen. Over 25 million students currently live in poverty, their families unable to access the academic resources that privileged students regularly enjoy. Educational Justice, an award-winning nonprofit startup, is tackling the growing opportunity gap by leveraging a powerful yet untapped resource.

After years of operating a successful tutoring and test preparation company Moshe Ohayon became disillusioned with the fact that a tremendous educational advantage is all too often only available to those from financially privileged backgrounds. He founded Educational Justice to help level the educational playing field for underserved students.

Moshe holds a B.S. in Applied Physics from Columbia University and a M.A. from the University of Louisville, where he studied linguistics and taught undergraduate courses in Hebrew language. Moshe is also the author of the award-

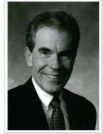

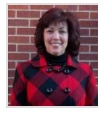
