About the presentation:

Ann Lee Hussey, Past District 7780 Governor and Global Advocate will share the similarities and differences she sees between the polio epidemic and our current COVID pandemic. In addition, she will explain how the network Rotary and its partners established to fight polio was used in part of the world during the Ebola crisis and now with COVID. Finally, she will discuss how the fight against polio continues despite the pandemic.

More About Ann Lee Hussey:

Ann Lee Hussey has made the eradication of polio and the alleviation of suffering by polio survivors her life's work. Over the past several years, she has actively participated in 30 volunteer NID (National Immunization Days) teams organizing and leading the last 26 teams herself, choosing to take those NIDs to place that do no often see westerners, where the need is greatest and where the publicity and goodwill surrounding the trip are as critical as the immunizations themselves to help communicate the need for eradication.
