Art schools reflect culture and Moira's talk will present ways that the contemporary artist might work as they address the topics and concerns of our time. Young people express their ambitions, their hopes and their dreams through art practice, film, sonic and visual cultures and a thriving college of art and design is symptomatic of a city on the move. creative and cultural industries are economic drivers that become part of not only a city's success but also of a country's GDP, identity, wellbeing and pride.
