
Note from Delene

Just a couple of things to share about our new meeting location.

We will be at the University Club Louisville, 200 E Brandeis Avenue. If you are coming from I65, after you pass the traffic circle at S Floyd St and E Brandeis Ave, you will turn left on S 1st Street (Manual HS will be on your right). It dead ends at the Information Center and you will turn left there, onto E Brandeis Ave. Don't be confused by two roads with the same name. Follow the yellow arrow in the image below to the parking lot. The gate will rise as you approach it; ignore the signs about restricted parking.



Once you come in the building, go to your left; we will be in Ballroom A. Check in and get your meal ticket if you purchased lunch; the buffet will be set up in an adjoining room. The table you see at the front below is for those who have purchased a salad with grilled chicken. The tables on the left and right are for those who purchased the regular buffet option; please grab your plate and help yourself. The desserts will be on the counter at the back. If you did not purchase a meal, feel free to go ahead and pick up your dessert and find a seat. Water and tea will be on the tables and coffee service will be in the main room. 
