Rotary Meeting - May 3, 2012

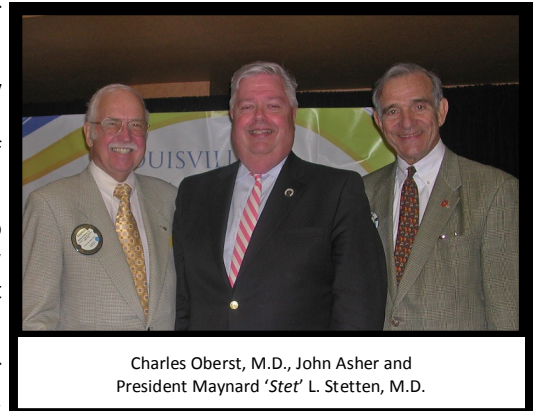
President Stet opened our traditional "Derby Meeting" and introduced Don Kohler for the appropriate invocation.
