encouraged to attend this year ♦s Virtual District Training Assembly.

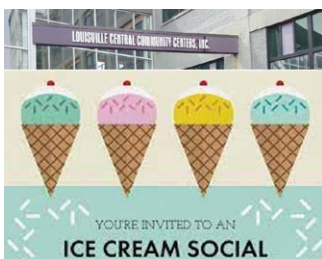
