Lisa Osanka, appointed Executive Director of the Louisville Metro Housing Authority in 2018, provided details of Louisville's tremendous accomplishment in securing "Choice Neighborhoods" grant funding for revitalization of the Russell neighborhood. Lisa reported that a \$29.5 M HUD Grant is leveraged with approximately \$200M in additional funding sources to implement the "Vision Russell Transformation Plan", including relocation and supportive services for Beecher Terrace families; vibrant, sustainable, mixed-use, mixed-income, multi-generational housing; and critical community improvements within the Russell neighborhood. Lisa's experience and leadership in neighborhood revitalization was evident and greatly appreciated as a true Louisville community asset.

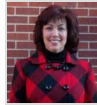
