Release Notes – March 12, 2011

Summary

Over the past weeks, we have focused on rewriting the **Business to Business** module. This work is still in progress. And, we completely reworked a major report area: Business Cards, which was requested by one of our users. This new report (**14.1 Business Cards**) allows the user to produce their own Rotary-styled business cards from the **DaCdb** system.


New Features / Changes

- 1) **Club Address.** To support the business card report, an Address 2 field was added to the club address.

Reports:

- 2) **14.1 Business Cards.** A new report with five (5) different business card templates has been added to the system. The five templates reflect the different formats or styles that are possible. Additional templates can be added by request and a small development fee.
- 3) **25.3 Event Labels.** The event label report was updated to use Arial Font and to use a consistent font-style.

- 1) **IsMyRotaryClub - COG, DLC, CCL.** We created a new set of links that do *not* include the leadership address, email and phone information. Contact support if you prefer to use these links.

Utilities

- 1) **Member Picture Import.** If you need to bulk load a number of Member pictures into the system, we have written two imports -- one that will take a picture lastname.firstname.jpg and one that will take the picture by nnnnnnn.jpg where nnnnnnn.jpg is the Member's RI MemberID.

Bug Fixes

- 1) **Story.** Stories did not deal well with image names that contained spaces. This is an Adobe issue, but the work-around is to remove the spaces from the name - which we do as part of the upload. This change should be transparent to all users. The DB and related files were all changed this past weekend.
- 2) **IsMyRotaryClub - Club Links.** Some links to club pages did not look to see if "http://" was part of the link before appending a "http://". This was corrected.
- 3) **Event Backroom Export.** The summary line was one column off when exported to Word. Fixed.

Business Card Styles









The new **14.1 Business Card** report has been loaded with five (5) templates or styles. Business cards can be run with one of four address options:

- Preferred Address
- Home Address
- Office Address
- Club Address

Business card uses the Avery 5390 template, which contains 10-business cards per page. There is an option to print 1 card for each member in the club/district (default) or 10 cards (1 page) for each member in the club / district. As usual, all printing should be done from Word (not the View to screen).
