## **Program**

Our inspiring and energetic guest speaker was Kathy Miller Wilson. She introduced us to her non-profit TAGGED, dedicated to helping change the trajectory of the talented, ambitious and gifted youth in foster care.

TAGGED's Mission ~ To help to change the trajectory of the talented ambitious and gifted youth in the foster care system

Vision ~ Giving youth in foster care the tools, resources, and opportunities to become the best version of themselves Our goal is to build future leaders by:

- ➤ Helping them to gain the skills they need to seize
- tomorrow's opportunities;
- Giving them the tools and enrichment opportunities necessary to successfully step into adulthood;
- > Striving to awaken their potential and harness their strengths;
- > Shining a light on the endless possibilities in front of them.

# TAGGED programs include:

- > STUFF-A-STOCKING: They host the annual "Stuff-A-Stocking" project to give youth in foster care a little extra at Christmas time. They collect and distribute donated stuffed Christmas stockings to 28 + local foster care agencies in VA.
- > BUILD-A-DREAM SCHOLARSHIPS: They award Five (5) \$1000 scholarships for youth in foster care to pursue their TAG (Talent, Ambitious, or Gift).
- > TAGGED PATHWAYS PROGRAMS: Transition to Independence Preparation: (9th grade and up (ages 15 23)



- > BE-TAGGED LIFE SKILLS Workshops: A series of life skills, and enrichment workshops to prepare them for successful transition to adulthood.
- > STUFF-A-TRUNK: Provide college-bound youth in the foster care system with basic needs such as items for their dorm, food, personal hygiene supplies and books.
- The SCOOP ~ A monthly distribution of available Scholarships, Internships, Apprenticeships, Training and Certifications, Job fairs, Employment Opportunities and more.



- ➤ RE-TAGGED Boutique ~ A Thrift Store that is a source of revenue to fund TAGGED programs and activities. We collect donations of upscale items and price them to bless our community. Foster youth shop at %50 off EVERYDAY!!
- Community Outreach/Partnerships: We establish partnerships with our community to fill unfunded gaps in the foster care system. We currently work with 28 local Department of Social Services (DSS) Foster Care agencies, and a host of other non-profit organizations.
