PROGRAM - Master Shu Amun

His goal is to use the way of the warrior way as a tool to restore the identity and life

conditioning of the individual. Helping to reduce fear, anxiety, uncertainty, and embrace the unknown and the warrior within.



September 20 - The Dictionary Project




This club legacy project has returned almost full strength this year. Over 2,000 Stafford County third graders will be receiving their own personal dictionaries to use this school year SY and then take home and keep as their very own. During October, the Stafford Rotary Club will be presenting personal dictionaries to third grade students in 15 of our 17 elementary schools.

This is a huge project and requires the support of ALL of our Rotary members. On September 27, come to the Howell library at ANY or ALL of the following times:

- 12:00 help transport 90 boxes of dictionaries down to Room 2,
- 3:00 start putting in Rotary plates,
- 5:30 8:00 enjoy food, fellowship & fun while we complete inserting the plates, sorting by school, and sending home the dictionaries with those of who will be presenting at each of the elementary schools.

The good news is that we have grown back this very special project, the bad news is that we now need to prepare and deliver 2,320 dictionaries!!! This is more than twice as many dictionaries as we delivered last year.
