Help us honor those who make a difference—submit your suggestions today and join us in celebrating the people who make North Bethesda a better place for all!

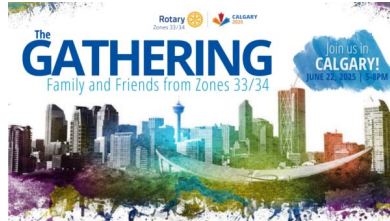
