## **AARP Grant to Help at Rotary Park**

The City of Houston was notified that they were the recipient of a 2025 AARP Community Challenge Grant! This generous support from AARP will be used in partnership with the Susitna Rotary Club to bring a handicap-accessible parking lot, trailhead, and picnic area to the Little Susitna Day Use Area (this is the lot in front of Little Susitna Rotary Park). This will make the park more accessible for people with mobility restrictions, and encourage more use of the facilities. This project is all about enhancing public access, inclusion, and outdoor enjoyment for residents and visitors of all ages and abilities.

The AARP Community Challenge grant program is part of the nationwide AARP Livable Communities initiative

The <u>AARP Community Challenge</u> grant program is part of the nationwide <u>AARP Livable Communities</u> initiative that helps communities make immediate improvements and jump-start long-term progress in support of residents of all ages. This grant was funded under the Flagship grants, which provide an opportunity for communities to apply for funding across several categories — and be creative about doing so.

Since its debut in 2017, the AARP Community Challenge has invested \$24.3 million in 2,100 livability projects, with a focus on meeting the needs of adults age 50 or older, in all 50 states, Puerto Rico, the U.S. Virgin Islands and Washington, D.C.
