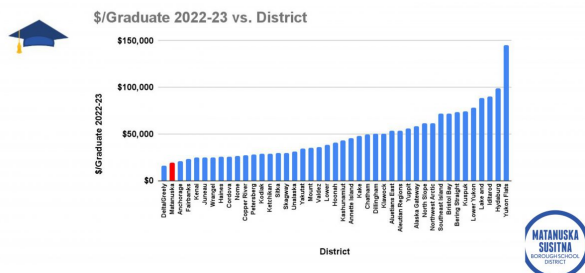
presented an interesting array of facts and figures about the current state of our borough's K-12 schools. The overall news was very positive. If you missed the meeting last week, you can view the [slideshow](#) with all the details here (we have permission to share the slides).

A few highlights from the presentation:

Enrollment is flat this year compared to the growth that has been experienced in previous years. The school district has hired demographers to provide more insight. Generally speaking, student enrollment tracks job growth, so, while the Valley's population may continue to grow, K-12 enrollment will not grow unless there is a corresponding increase in jobs.

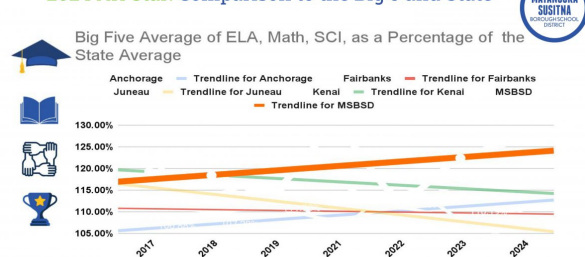
Cost per graduate: MSBSD is second in the district in terms of cost and is the least expensive of the five biggest districts in the state (Anchorage, MatSu, Fairbanks, Kenai, Juneau).

Cost Per Graduate: 22-23 Report Card to the Public



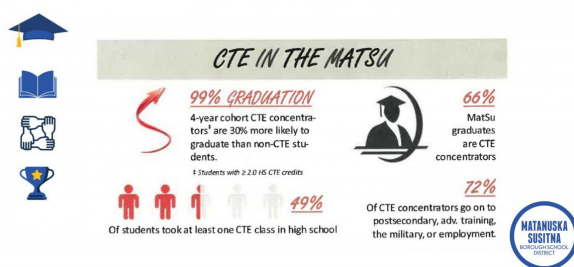
Trends are improving: MSBSD has steadily been improving in testing results for ELA (English/language arts), Math, SCI (Science)

2024 AK Star: Comparison to the Big 5 and State

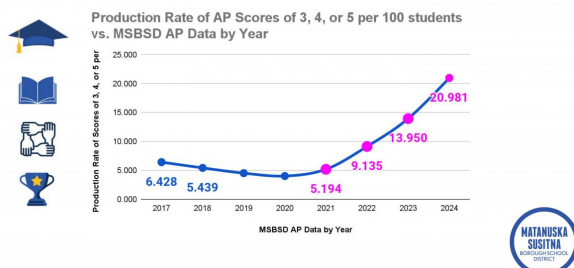

Bad News – Good News

We are still fighting polio in Afghanistan and Pakistan. To date there are 34 cases. The surveillance teams are equipped and able to track and find cases much more readily than in the past. As a result, more cases have been discovered. The good news is that once cases are discovered, precautions can be made effectively.

World Health Organization. Numbers now at 34. **Wild Polio Virus Summary:**

The number of wild polio cases for 2024 as of Sept 1, 2024 is 34.

There were 17 in Pakistan and 17 in Afghanistan.

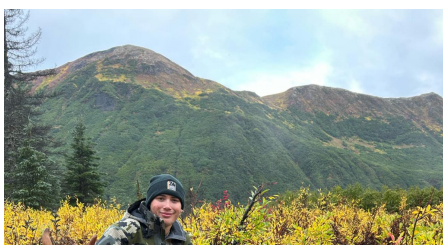

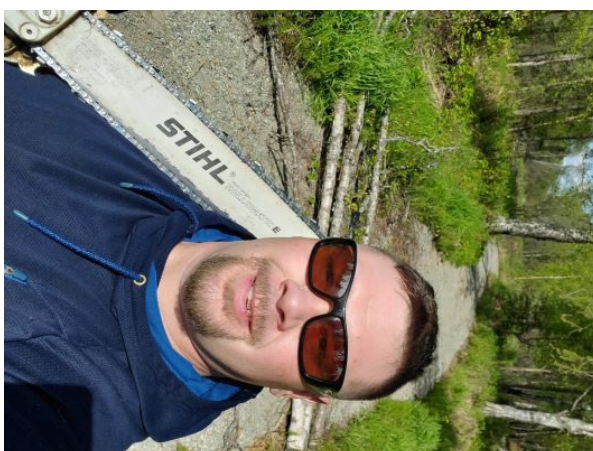

- 1 basket for a "live auction teaser"(value ~\$250) - Susitna's basket theme is **Rotary Bling**

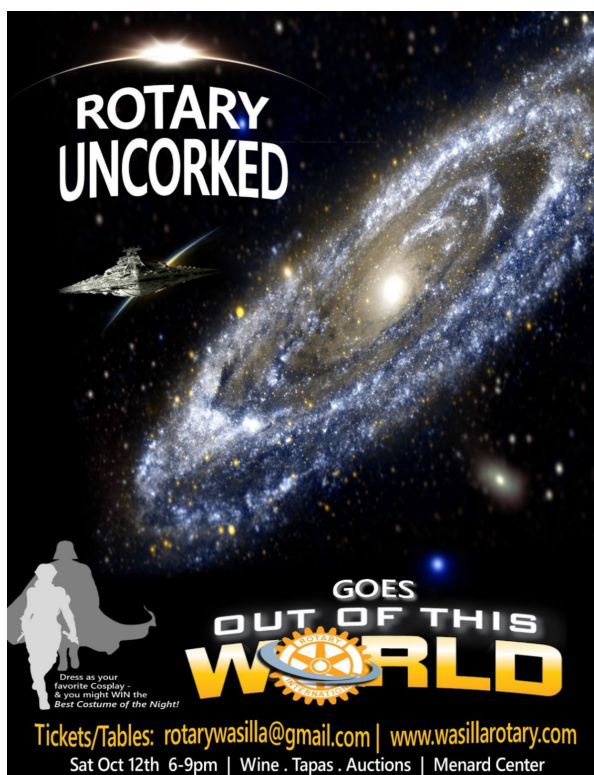
