This update from our Rotary Youth Exchange student abroad.

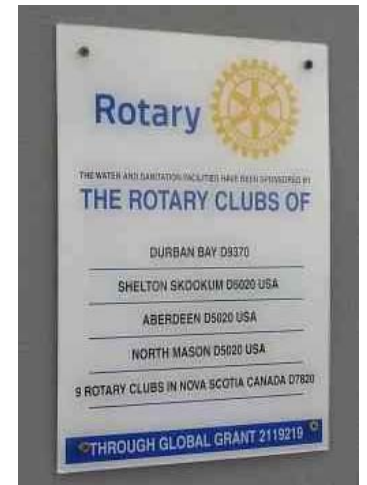
Hi Josh,

Siyajabula Orphanage Rotary Global Project

This plaque has been displayed in recognition of a Global Grant providing bathrooms, secure fencing, solar, water storage, veg garden, drainage and paving at an orphanage which had outgrown its facility. Rotary identified it as a worthy place to install better water and sanitation. Aberdeen Rotarians stepped up to contribute \$1000, and the group's total donation was \$2000 to the Global Grant, which typically x5 the donation, so each \$1 from a club is met with \$5 from RI.
