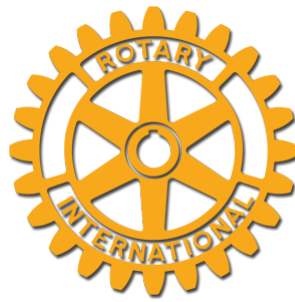

March 8, 2023 Meeting | Main St Tax Credits



Since 2005, the Main Street Tax Credit Incentive Program has provided Business & Occupation (B&O) tax or Public Utility Tax (PUT) credits for contributions given to eligible downtown revitalization initiatives in the state of Washington. After receiving approval from the Department of Revenue, a business may receive a credit for 75% of the value of a contribution made to an eligible Washington Main Street Community or 75% of the value of the contribution made to the Main Street Trust Fund.

Rotarians Erin DenAdel and Cathy Williams will be on hand to explain the details and benefits involving eligible contributions.

DACdb experienced an outage...and why you may have received 3 newsletters

This notification landed earlier today:

The DACdb platform experienced an unexpected outage March 7th due to a perfect storm of events that took the DACdb server down and took quite a bit of work to come back online. They are back online at this time, and over the next several hours will evaluate the stability of the system. Please know that there was NOT any type of breach. This situation was a combination of several software scenarios that were interfering with each other, combined with what looked like a possible heavy attack on server requests, all occurring at the same time. No data was compromised or at risk through
