Volunteers for Business Week Still Needed

Company Advisors and Judges are still needed for the 24th annual Aberdeen Rotary Business Week program at Aberdeen High School. This year's program is scheduled for the week of March 25-29. Helping a young person achieve his or her career aspirations is a great way to support Rotary's object of vocational service. Aberdeen Rotarians are invited to get involved and help support juniors in the Class of 2025.

There are two ways to volunteer. The first is to be a Company Advisor for the week helping to lead a Company of students through the curriculum and a variety of activities alongside an Aberdeen staff member as the students learn all about business and marketing principles, and even more importantly, 21st Century skills. This involves being in attendance the entire week and doing a training session on March 20th in the afternoon.

The other volunteer option is as a judge on Friday, March 29th. Students will have been immersed in the week-long event mentored by their Company Advisors. At the end of the week, many community volunteers are needed to serve as judges for some of the culminating events.
