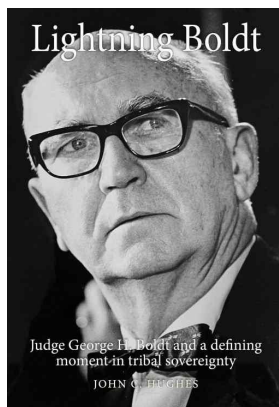

**Sneak Peek at Next Week**



Next week's meeting at the Log Pavilion moves from noon to evening starting with hearty appetizers at 5:30.p.m. and program at 6:00. Our guest speaker is Past President John Hughes who will discuss his newest book *Lightning Boldt*, a biography of Judge George H. Boldt that explores the aftermath of Boldt's historic ruling on fishing rights.

Hughes is the Chief Historian for the Office of Secretary of State, and former editor and publisher of *The Daily World*. He attended the trial that reaffirmed Native Americans' right to up to 50 percent of the harvestable salmon. Called the

"Boldt Decision" it resulted in competition between commercial, recreational, and Native interests, leading to over harvesting the salmon runs. Upheld by the Supreme Court, the eventual consensus was to name the tribes co-managers with the state in order to preserve the fisheries.
