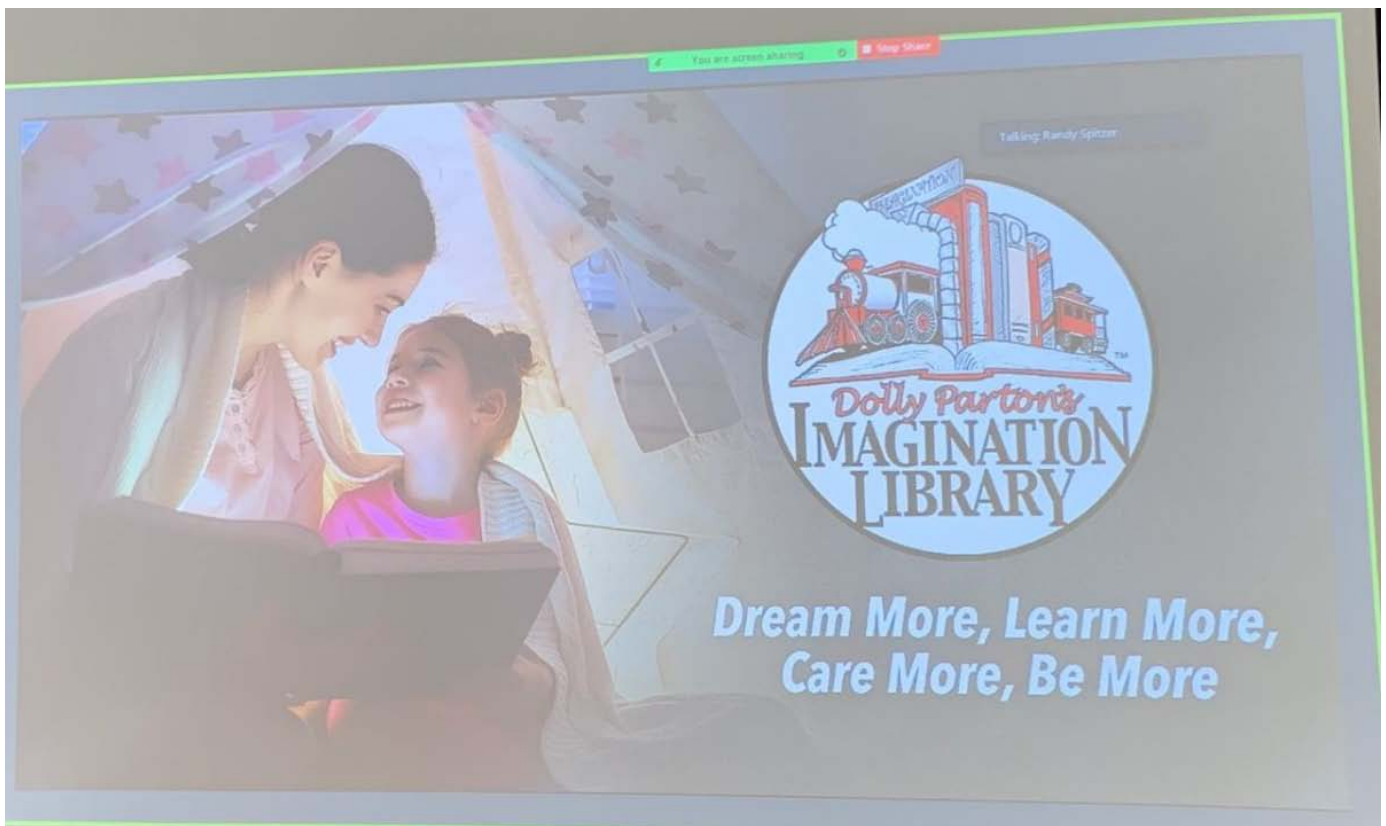

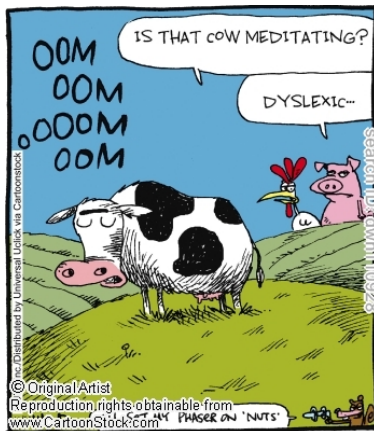


Raffle lady Donna Lormor had tickets ready...Jim Castino gets 10 free next week, John Eddy drew a white worth \$15.
