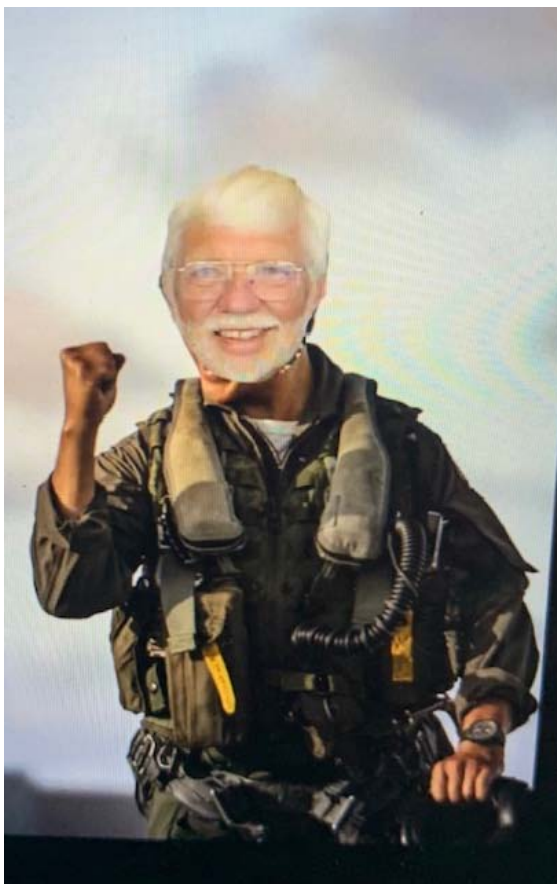

Pat & Pam talked about the upcoming Fundraiser for American cancer. See Pat for the ticket sign up sheet.

PP Pam had fun with some of the red badgers on who could remember who's name. There were a couple of fun fines and a number of folks offered up happy bucks.





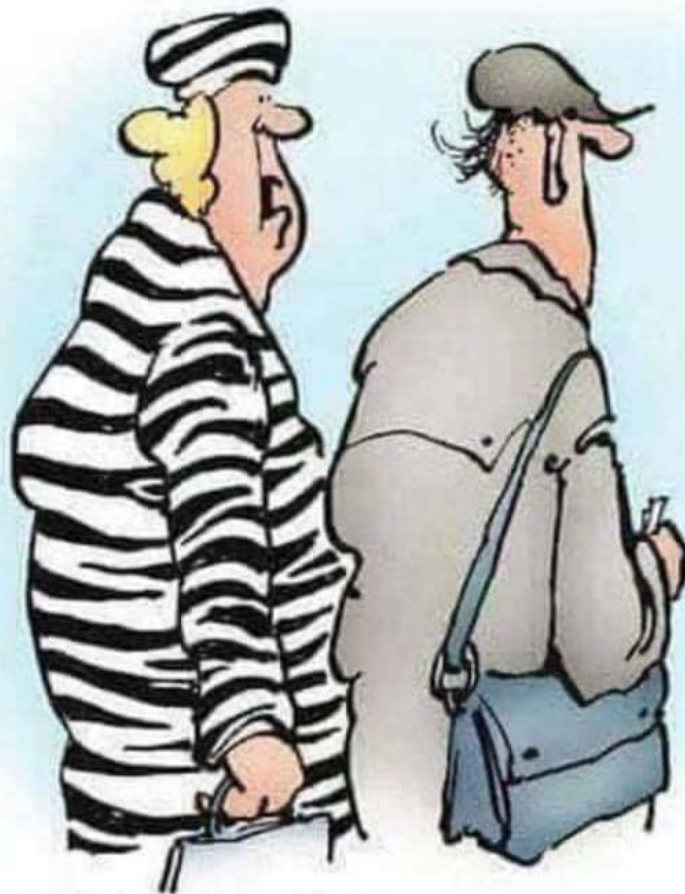


Jim Castino organized a fun " Top Gun " outing where obviously there was a lot of fun had by the group

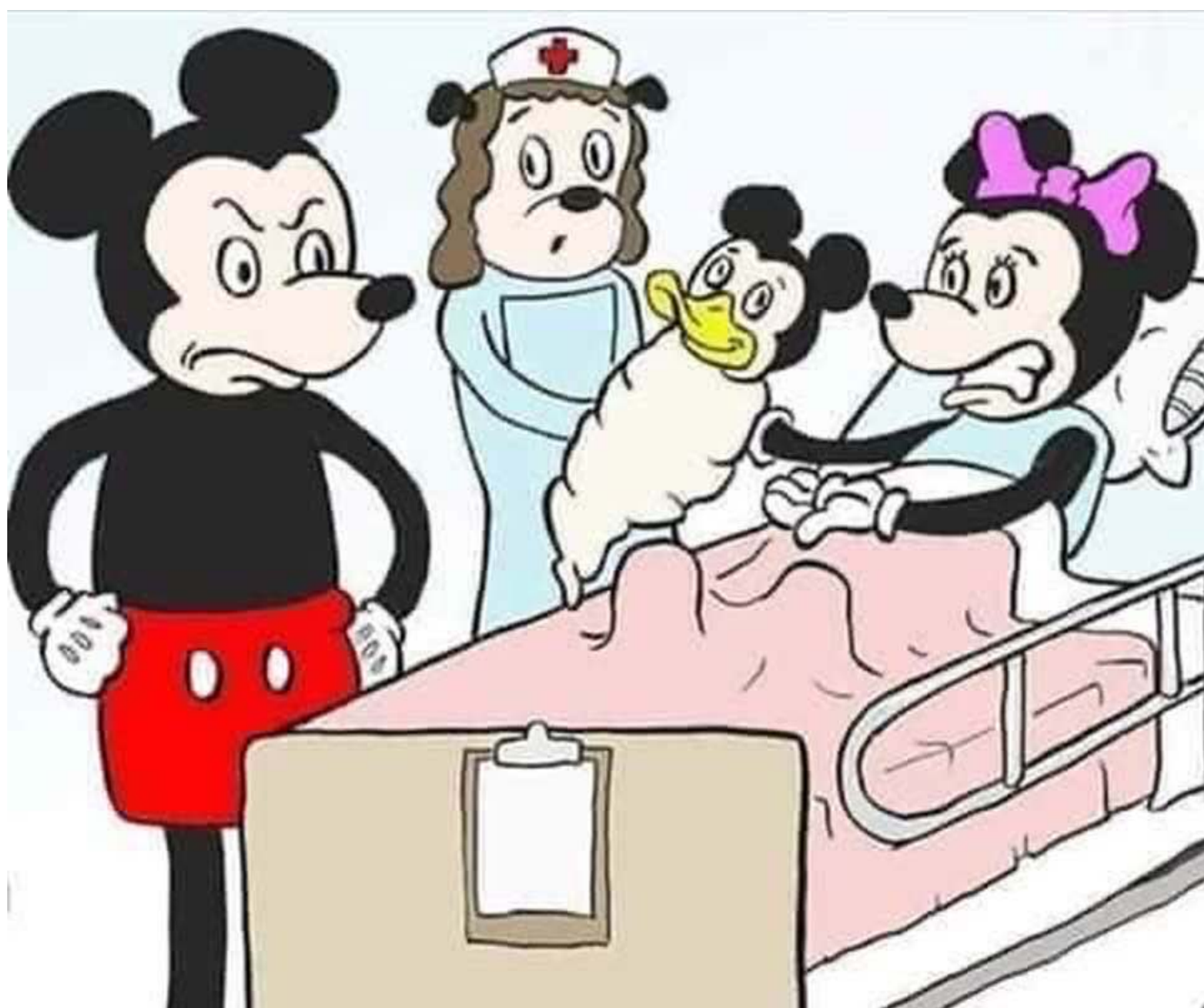


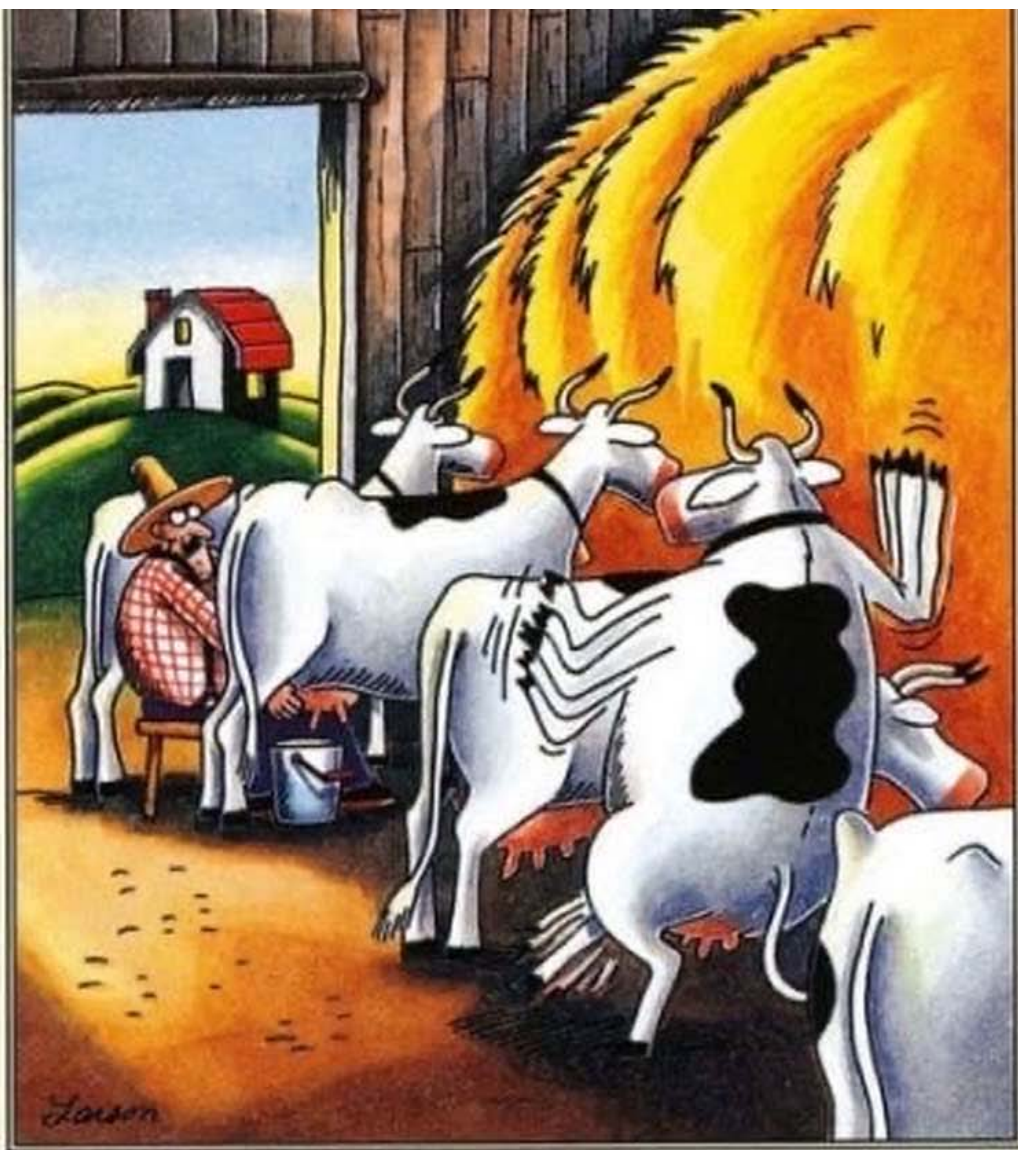

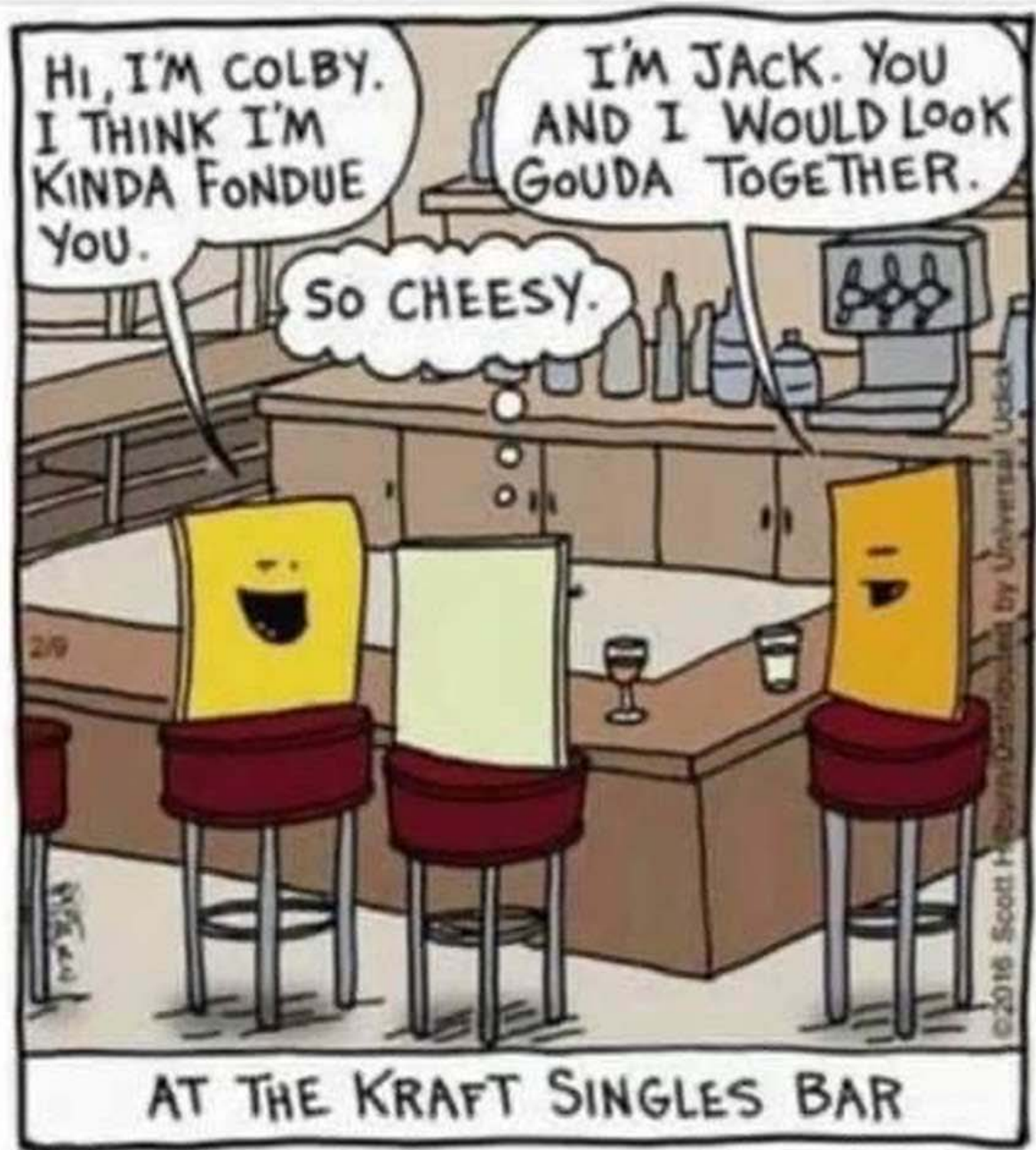
