Duck Central Hours and Location

It's Duck Race time. Months of planning by our fellow Rotarians has brought us close to Race Day!

This means it's also time for Duck Central to be open and operating. **Please read important instructions below regarding turn-in of ALL duck tickets on Thursday, July 28 if you are not selling during Whaling Days weekend.**

Duck Central

Location: Jenne Wright building (in the board room at the back of the building. This is at the intersection of NW Anderson Hill Rd and Silverdale Way)

Times:

- Thursday, July 28th: after Duck Tagging to 6 pm**.
- Friday, July 29th: 9 am to 6 pm**.
- Saturday, July 30th: 8 am to 6 pm** (note: Whaling Days Parade starts at 9am)
- Sunday, July 31st: 9 am on

****If you know you will be selling in the evening at Whaling Days or other venues please stop in and get tickets before Duck Central closes.**

Ticket Control - Three important factors to consider:

- **When Duck Central opens at approximately 2 pm on Thursday, July 28th, ALL ticket distribution and collection will occur at Duck Central.** Kitsap Bank will no longer be issuing tickets or collecting funds.
- **We ask that any Rotarian not selling tickets during Whaling Days weekend turn in their pads - sold or not - at either the Duck Tagging or on Thursday afternoon at Duck Central. We need these pads in the hands of the active sellers on the weekend. Also, any pads outstanding by 3:00 pm on Sunday, July 31st with their whereabouts unknown will be voided.**
- **Rotarians selling during Whaling Days are asked to contact Duck Central by noon on Sunday with the status of their sales activities.** Except for a handful of Rotarians at known locations inside Whaling Days, sales should cease at 2 pm and all tickets -- sold or not -- returned to Duck Central.

What is Duck Central?

Duck Central is a central location to the activities of the Whaling Days weekend. The proximity to the Parade Route, Whaling Days activities in Old Town Silverdale, and easy access by car allows for Rotarians to quickly drop off sold tickets and funds and get issued new pads of tickets.

During this hot weather Duck Central will also be a place to sit inside, have a light snack, and get some water.
