The group installed 110 Aller clean-air wood-burning stoves in Blanca Flor, Guatemala. The stoves were designed in Everett and are manufactured locally in Barillas. They use 50% less firewood, cook 40% more efficiently and, importantly, with proper venting, negate smoke-caused respiratory illness - especially in women and children.

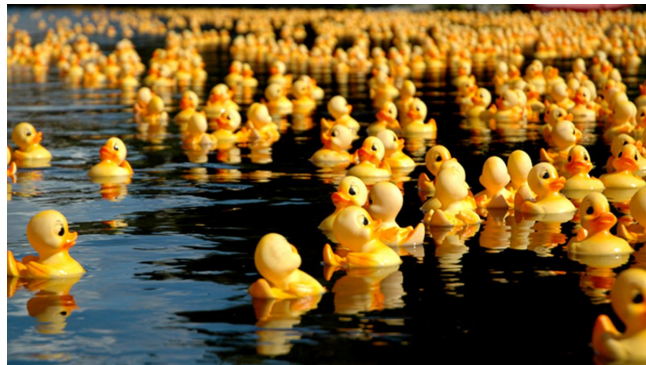
