He built and ran them successfully, then sold both to Fortune 500 companies after 20 years. He then became a CEO for a Paul Allen company. His humanitarian work now exceeds \$60 million in reaching over 10 million individuals.

A pilot for 43 years on wheels and floats, he also holds a US Coast Guard Master Captains license, Past Commodore of the Seattle Yacht Club. Kim lives with his wife Jill in Bellevue, WA.
