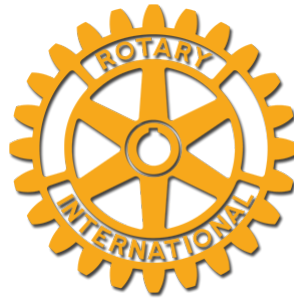

Rubber Ducky Tickets Being Ordered!

The Rubber Ducky Race is set for July 22nd at 4:30. We have several sponsors already lined up (see who they are at www.rentonrotary.org) and tickets will be in your hands soon. Each Renton Rotarian will receive, at minimum, 3 books of tickets - 30 tickets total and are to be sold at \$5 each. You have options! Each ticket number that is assigned to you must be accounted for. Pesky gambling rules.

Sell them to friends, family, co-workers, people you come in contact with
Buy them yourself to increase your chances of winning
Give the club \$150 as a donation and never see a ticket

New this year! **Yes, tickets can be paid for with a credit card!** Here's how it will work: Purchaser will be directed to a website via a QR code we will provide you. Using their phone, they will plug in their information to purchase however many tickets they want. When they show you the screen that the charge went through, you can give them the tickets. Be sure they fill out the stubs as we will need that information. The ticket numbers will not be associated with that person any other way.

The QR code will not be published online as we don't want people buying tickets without a Rotarian there to give them the physical ticket. This may sound a bit convoluted, but the only other option is having a bunch of card readers floating about and keeping track of them is not a task anyone wants to manage! And if it's more than you want to do, tell the buyer no cards but you'll take cash. You do you.

The Rubber Ducky Race is our second-most profitable fundraiser and our goal is \$20,000 in profit. Last year we made \$15,000. We're getting an earlier start and we need you to help us get to goal! More info coming soon.
