Cascade Choirs Crescendo Fundraiser Campaign



Dr. Tracey L. Edou, Superintendent of Cascade School District, and also one of our Leavenworth Rotary Club members would like to share the following information:

Hello Cascade Choir Students and Families - We are so excited to share the good news that in collaboration with the Cascade PTSA, Band and Choir Boosters, and the Cascade School District, we have a vision for how to ensure that there is a choir program for the 2024-25 school year and beyond. It is called the Cascade Choir Crescendo Campaign and its goal is to raise \$65,000 for the 2024-25 choir program.

Raising \$65,000 may sound like a lot, but we are confident that we can meet this goal if we work together. Especially because up to \$20,000 will be matched by a community donor! The campaign has been live for just over 24 hours and we are already \$2,700 closer to our goal!

The Crescendo Campaign is a group effort. Within the campaign you get to create your own fundraiser as an individual or a team to support the effort. Check out the campaign here: <https://tinyurl.com/CrescendoCampaign>. From the main campaign page, you decide what your personal or team fundraising target is (what amount of money you want to raise for the Crescendo Campaign), and then enter your email address and name. The platform will help you create your own fundraising page and lead you through how to send out donation requests to family and friends near and far. With our \$20,000 matching grant, if you raise \$200 for the Crescendo Campaign, your \$200 will become \$400 once we receive the match! Amazing, right?

You can keep it simple and just send out donation requests, or you can get creative and use your love of music and performance to help you in your fundraiser! Here are some ideas to get you started:

• offer singing telegrams that you record on your phone and email or text to your friends and family in exchange for their donation.

• Make a plan with a local business or establishment to show up with your choir friends and sing a set of tunes for tourists coming through the shop or restaurant.

• Hold a benefit concert at your family's home or in a park and raise funds through attendance at the event.

Our goal is to raise \$20,000 by June 30 to obtain the match. If we can make it all the way to the \$65,000 target by June 30, even better. Thank you in advance for joining us in this journey. We know that together we are far more powerful than any one individual.

and Rotary. This event is sponsored by the Rotary Clubs of Cashmere, Chelan, East Wenatchee, Leavenworth, Wenatchee, Wenatchee Confluence, and Wenatchee Sunrise.

Are Rotarians playing baseball?

No, but that would be fun! Instead, the Wenatchee Applesox are playing the Kelowna Falcons. We are delighted that our District 5060 Governor, Marjolein Lloyd, will throw out the first pitch. Area 8 Assistant Governor and Wenatchee Rotarian Mike Kintner will sing the national anthems.

What time does the game start and end?

Start time is 6:35 pm. Each game is different, but you can expect the full game to last until roughly 9 pm.

How do I buy tickets

Purchase your tickets using the promo code "rotary" via the [Wenatchee Applesox](#) website. You have two ticket choices: 1. General admission bleacher seats for \$5. General admission seats are bleacher style and don't have backs. OR 2. You can purchase a seat with a back for \$10.50 by choosing a seat in Reserved Seating, Section D. You will be close to Rotarians and can easily visit and chat.

Will I be able to sit with other Rotarians?

Yes, bleachers along third base will be set aside for Rotarians. You can sit in this section with the purchase of a General Admission ticket. You can purchase a seat with a back in Reserved Seating Section D and be near the Rotary bleacher section.

Can I bring my portable bleacher seat so I have a backrest?

Yes

What can I eat at the game?

The Applesox stadium has a concession stand where you can purchase sodas, beers, wine, burgers, dogs, popcorn, etc.

Will there be a 50/50 raffle during the game?

Yes, we plan to hold a 50/50 raffle during the game with proceeds going to the nonprofit [Only7Seconds](#). Tickets are \$3 each or 4 for \$10.

What is Only7Seconds?

Only7Seconds is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit addressing youth loneliness by encouraging and empowering individuals & partners to connect with others who matter in their lives. Its strategic priority is to address the youth and young adult loneliness epidemic by reaching and empowering 500,000 youth and young adults (ages 8-24).

Only7Seconds offers a youth and school program curriculum that inspires intentional connection, an ambassador program, an advocacy and awareness program, and the I Know Lonely story sharing project. It is based in Chelan, WA but has a nationwide reach.

Will we be spreading the word about Rotary at this event?

Yes, this is a marketing event that is also fun! There will be a booth with Rotary materials (each Club can provide materials to Mike Kintner or Kathleen), announcements about Rotary between innings, a short video about Rotary and more!

Do you need volunteers the night of the game?

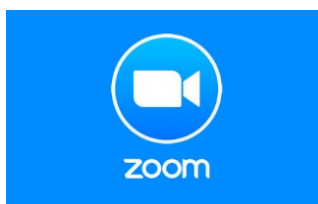
