Hands On Help Needed




There are two projects that Leavenworth Rotary is working on, and we need your help!

News From Co-President Melanie

Welcome to our new Rotary Year!

Thank you to all of you who came out for the Installation Dinner last Thursday. It was a great time in a beautiful environment with lovely people. Who could ask for more?

Celebrating Mahala's very accomplished year was hugely humbling! She has been such an awesome leader and inspiring person, it really will take 2 of us to maintain the high standard that she has set for our club.



As you may know, Kiffen and I are an experiment in a sense. We are the first ever Co-Presidents for Leavenworth Rotary, and we hope that you all bear with us while we work through the ins and outs of how this will all work in practice. Since we have had many questions about what our Co-Presidency will look like, I've included some FAQ info for you below:

Will you divide the year in half so that you are each President for six months?

Although this is the most common model in Rotary, *we will divide the year into 2 for running the Friday General Meetings and Board Meetings only*. Kiffen will run the meetings from July through December, and Melanie will run them from January through June. We will fill in for each other if we cannot attend meetings (s) during our six months.

How will you divide the responsibilities of the President between the two of you?

Kiffen, with her extensive experience in student engagement and community outreach, will spearhead these areas. Melanie will focus on the operational side: digital communication, document creation and management, and tech-related tasks, and will continue to work on the Public Image team. However, we would both like to be included in communications, so we both know what is happening when we fill in for each other.

Will you both be voting members of the Board and attend Board meetings?

Yes, we will both be voting members of the Board and will both attend Board meetings. We will take turns running the Board meetings along with the General meetings (Kiffen will do this from July to December, and Melanie from January to June). We will discuss the Agenda before the meetings, and Melanie will distribute the Agenda, financial documents, other documents, and the Zoom link before the meeting.

As this is the first time the club will have co-Presidents, we understand that there may be some uncertainty. We ask for your patience and assure you that we are here to address any questions or concerns you may have. Your feedback is valuable to us as we put this plan into practice.

As always, thank you for all you do for Rotary, and I'm looking forward to spending more time with you all!
