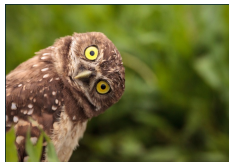

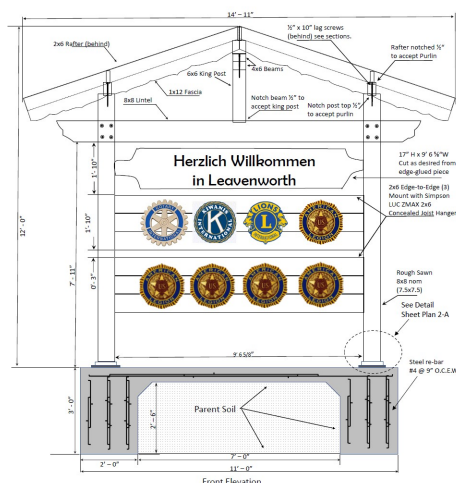
Hands On Help Needed

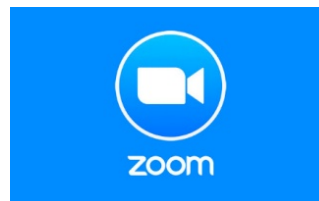
