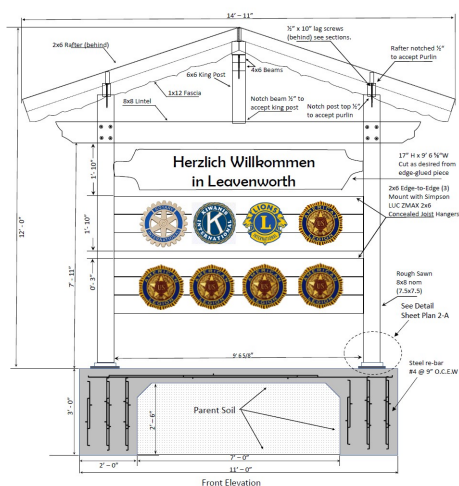

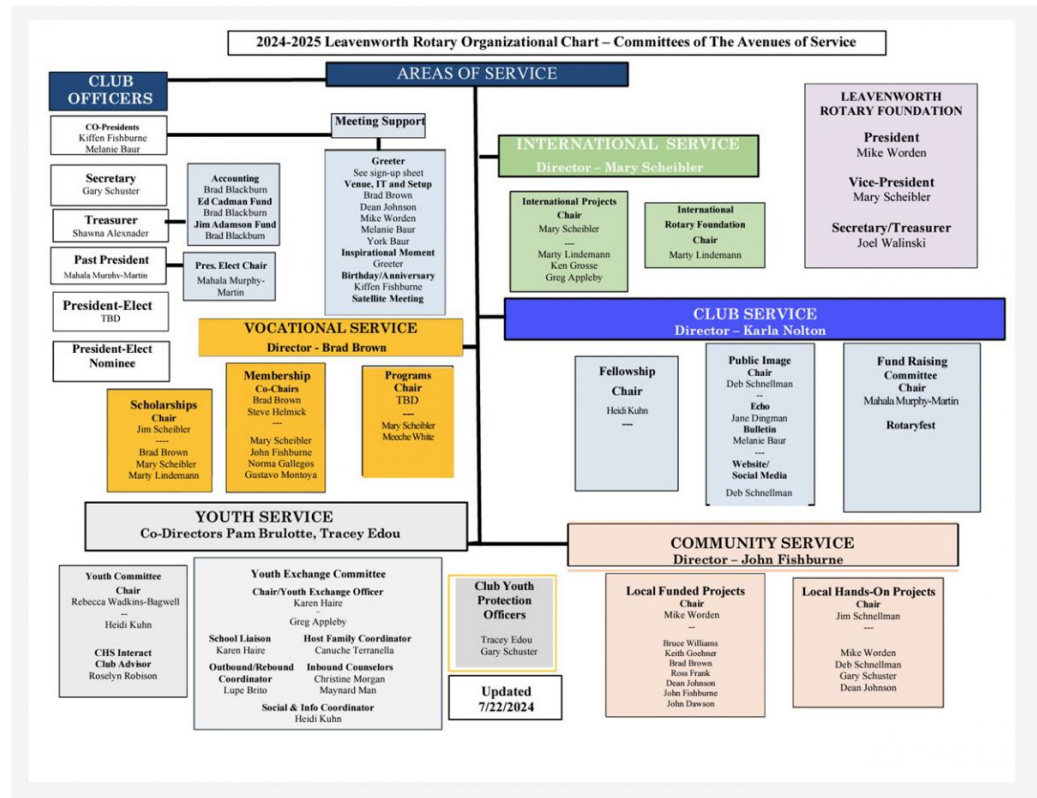

Rotary Dues - Couple Discount Explained

Due to some confusion about how the couple's discount is applied for the 2024-2025 Rotary year, here is the "couples discount" explained:

Who is eligible: A couple that are cohabitating and are both active members of the Leavenworth Rotary Club.

Amount of Discount: The discount is 20% off dues for both members. This year, a couple will be charged \$416 for dues, rather than the \$520 they would pay without the discount. The amount charged is 20% off the full amount of \$520, for a discount of \$104 per couple.

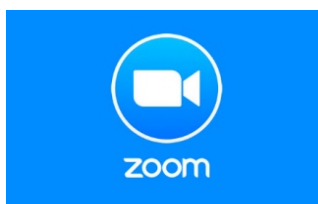
