Thank You to our Speakers Last Week!

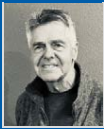
Our speakers last week were **Marty Lindemann** and **Mary Scheibler** who presented Rotary's **World Polio Day!**



Marty and Mary presented the progress that Rotary has made combating Polio since the work began in 1985 by Dr. Ed Cadman (who also started our very own Leavenworth Rotary Club), other organizations that they have partnered with, and the work still left to do. The stats shared with us were shocking and/or impressive, such as:

- In 1985 there were 800,000 deaths and 8 million victims affected by paralysis.
- Polio cases have been reduced by 99.9% since 1988.

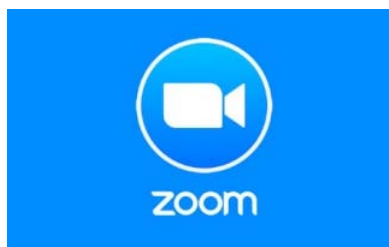
