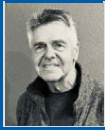
Thank You to our Speaker Last Week!

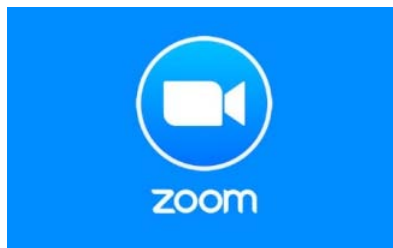
