## **Rotary Dues - Couple Discount Explained**

Due to some confusion about how the couple's discount is applied for the 2024-2025 Rotary year, here is the "couples discount" explained:

**Who is eligible:** A couple that are cohabitating and are both active members of the Leavenworth Rotary Club.

**Amount of Discount:** The discount is 20% off dues for both members. This year, a couple will be charged \$416 for dues, rather than the \$520 they would pay without the discount. The amount charged is 20% off the full amount of \$520, for a discount of \$104 per couple.

I was reading our August Rotary Magazine, on pg. 18 & 19, there was a fascinating article about  $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{R}$  People of action around the globe $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{R}$ . It really inspired me to see what other clubs are doing.

1. Belize City, renovating a school and a park as part of its Youth-focused agenda.

2. The club of Columbia, purchased about \$600 of school supplies and delivered

 $100 \; \text{sets}$  of notebooks, pencils, pens, erasers, sharpeners and more to students

around the city.

3. Liberia, with financial support from the Rotary Club of Loveland, Colorado helped train 200 young women to establish microenterprises to make and sell reusable sanitary pads and address the high, recurring cost of pads that makes them out of reach for many families that struggle to make ends meet, that leads thousands of girls to miss classes so often that they eventually drop out of school.

It was a very interesting and inspiring article…it made me wonder, how many of our members take the time to read this magazine and broaden our horizons of what we might endeavor to do or join another club to reach out into the world to help those less fortunate than we are.

I for one often find myself rather complacent sometimes about others that are less fortunate than myself. That $\hat{a} \in \mathbb{M}$ s one reason I love Rotary and the Rotary magazine that
