

### Last week, 03/13/25 - WSU Sports-Science Fun



Following his introduction by Ken Robertson, Dr. Lloyd Smith challenged every member to think like engineers as he proceeded to explain in fairly simple terms the primary factors influencing the flight of baseballs and rockets, which are gravity, lift, drag, and turbulence.

To justify his trip here, he briefly praised his WSU Engineering School as being awesome, and offered to help any interested local student to learn more about it, and also offered to give tours of his laboratory.

Dr. Smith established the **Sports Engineering Labortory** when he was approached, shortly after joining the WSU faculty, by a company interested in baseball bat design and performance. Presently, nearly all USA baseball and softball bats are certified in his lab. He loves baseball, and could talk for hours about the science of baseball. In his presentation today, he focused on how he was approached by major-league baseball to investigate the recent increase in homeruns. His findings were fascinating. He answered many questions.

PARKING - You can get your parking permit prior to arrival at home the day of the event. Or, do it sitting in your car at the parking lot. Here is how. Wenatchee Valley College has transitioned to the

**HONK** mobile parking permit system at the Wenatchee campus starting in the fall quarter 2024. Scan the QR code see below (OR Send a text to 75498 with the Message 54506). Either one will bring up the permit page. You do not need to create an account, and you do not need to download an app.

- 1. Scan and open the code
- 2. Enter your license plate number
- 3. Choose rate (daily)
- 4. Look for the words in red "add promo" and select
- 5. Enter promo code FOUNDATIONGUEST2425
- 6. Select apply
- 7. Total will now say zero.
- 8. Click blue bar that says park for free

Your parking pass is valid in regular and visitor parking spaces (not reserved spaces).

Alternate free parking is available at the National Guard Armory, only in their EAST lot, a short scenic walk from the venue. The armory is east of the campus on 5th Street.
