# Nakusp Rotary reaches 150% of its online Silent Auction goal!

The online silent auction organised by the Rotary Club of Nakusp in the last week of November raised over \$6000, which was 150% of their target and a record for the club's online auctions. The club attributed the success to the generosity of both the donors of items and the 60+ bidding participants. Gift cards and gift certificates were the most popular, being seven out of the ten most active items. A generous cash donation by NACFOR financed the purchase of six grocery gift cards, which together raised \$845. Two bottles of wine from Nakusp's Valley of the Springs winery and a bear sculpture by Hugh Egener were also hotly competed.

In the last few years, the Rotary Club of Nakusp has attracted over \$500,000 to the Nakusp community from grants, donations and fundraising initiatives. The club has supported local causes such as the foodbank and hospice, awarded scholarships to local students, financed the Nakusp waterfront lighting and the Adventure Park projects and donated to other local clubs. Rotary also supports selected international projects such as <u>"End Polio Now"</u> and <u>ShelterBox</u>.

The club conducts three major fundraising activities during the year – the online auction, the wine festival and the concession trailer which serves food on Canada Day as well as for visiting clubs and groups during the summer. During the COVID epidemic, Nakusp participated in a Rotary online bingo project which netted over \$50,000 to the community.

Earlier this fall, I had the opportunity to meet Lucy, a grandmother from Grenada, who shared her story of resilience and the impact you've made on her life. When a Category 5 hurricane hit her island in Grenada, Lucy was unable to evacuate to a shelter because she was caring for her disabled son. During the storm, Lucy took refuge with her son, protecting him behind the concrete wall of her tiny bathroom. When the storm lifted, Lucy's home and entire community were destroyed.

ShelterBox responded in the aftermath of the hurricane, and because of your support, provided Lucy with a customized shelter package, including an emergency relief tent, solar lanterns, a kitchen set, and a mosquito net. This enabled Lucy to create a space filled with warmth, comfort, and hope for her family.
