Board of Directors Update:

We approved an additional plaque to recognize ignite in the Rotary Centennial Park, selected our Rotarian of the Month for July, and received and accepted, with regrets, a temporary Leave of Absence request from Kimber Gates, to become effective on July 1, 2023.

Centennial Park Update:

The park is not quite complete as we are still waiting for the Rotary medallions to be installed – a special drill bit that is required for the project is backordered. Additionally, the construction teams are waiting on a part to fix the water fountain. Late winter storms took out the remaining park trees, but additional trees are scheduled to be planted by the City. The cost for the park came in at about \$1.2 million. Of that, our Club contributed approximately \$515,000. The Board, along with our Social committee, is looking for ways to utilize the park, not only for our Club's benefit, but for the community as well.

DAN CRAWFORD gave an update on the Dominican Republic literacy project. Our club's International Services Committee provided \$1,500 and with the matching grants, total support came to \$14,000.
