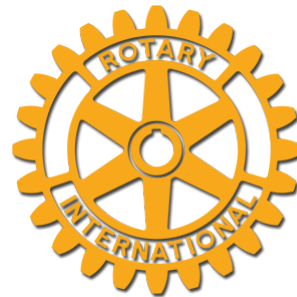

In 1984 Candace enrolled at the University of Idaho as a non-traditional 24 year old freshman. She graduated in 1988 with a BS in Animal Science and minors in journalism and advertising. She sold advertising to radio stations for a bit and in 1990 became the Community Relations Director for Gritman Medical Center.
