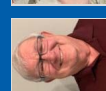

The first generation subs were primarily stealth, to go fast. The Virginia class subs were meant to decrease noise in the water with testing and refining at the Naval Acoustic Research Detachment in Bayview, Idaho. This facility is as big as a NFL football stadium and the testing done in Lake Pend Oreille at the research detachment allows the Navy to do things with submarines that cannot be done anywhere else in the United States. The shape and materials used in subsequent submarine classes were all meant to decrease the "flow" of what others hear in the water and the noise that sonar picks up.

The USS Idaho is within six months of christening the vessel. Rather than champagne, the submarine will be christened with waters from Redfish Lake in central Idaho, Henry's Fork of the Snake River in southeastern Idaho and Lake Pend Oreille in the north. The submarine is 377 feet long and has a 34 foot hull diameter. It will hold a crew of 145 with 8-10 officers in command. The sub has its own systems for desalination, oxygen, and more, and can stay underwater for a good amount of time...until the crew runs out of food!
