### LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM

Mike Roberts' guest presenter was Tony Bean, executive director of Pullman-Moscow Airport.

Some high points:

- New runway, now in service, accommodates much larger planes--a military Galaxy C-17 and a Boeing 757 to date.
- It has plenty of room for 737s, the preferred plane by WSU and UI for charters.
- The runway was expanded and realigned because it was originally designed for 19-passenger planes.
- Also the old runway aimed planes directly toward Moscow Mountain.
- The taxiway is now 400 feet from the runway, double what it was.
- Total cost was \$158 million.
- The new terminal, some 49,000 square feet, will go on line late this year.
- It will have two jetways and a full baggage carousel.
- Lots of seating, a restaurant and a bar.
- Total cost about \$90 million.
- The old airport averaged 90 flights per year that were diverted due to weather.
- With the installation of cutting-edge technology (that Tony convinced the FAA they needed), only 9 flights were diverted last year.
- Tony is working on adding a direct flight to Denver that would gain 39 additional connections over what is currently served by Seattle.
- Pullman-Moscow will not be competing with Lewiston-Nez Perce County Airport for direct flights to Salt Lake City.
