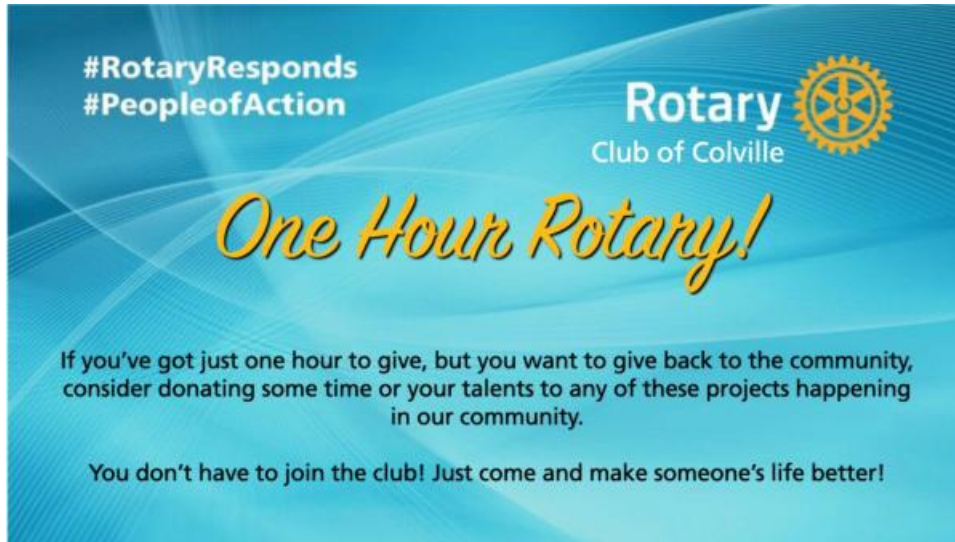


## Volunteer Opportunities

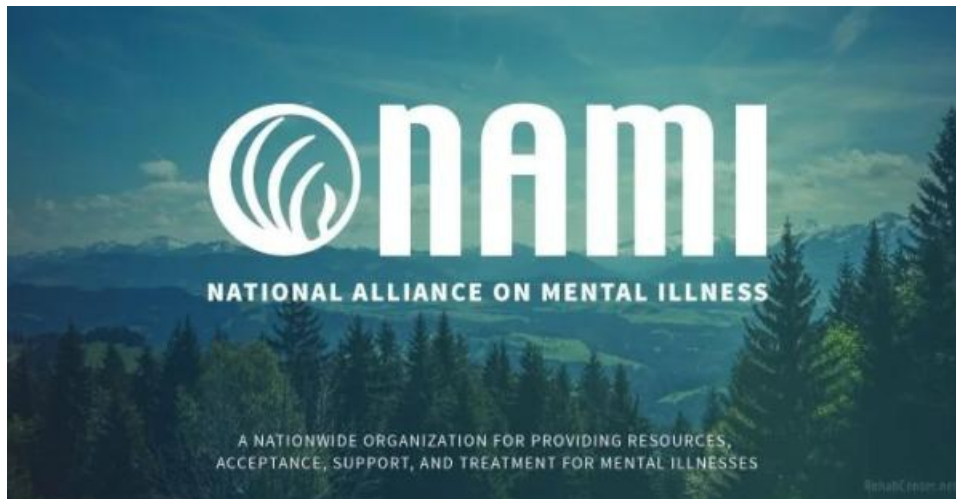
