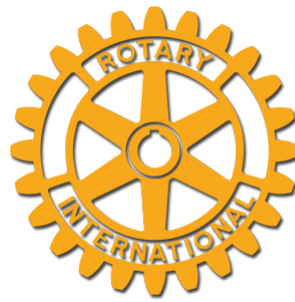

- **Pres Gin** advised that her and **Scott Veitch** were reviewing our insurance needs based on the District recommending a different insurance company. More to follow on this.

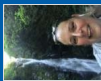
