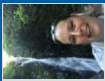

Program: Power Plant at Smith Creek Falls

- Peter Gray from Idaho came to present
- Runs power plant at Smith Creek Falls
 - West Creston in Port Hill
- Hydro electric plant 16km from here
 - On a calm quiet morning, you likely can hear in spring if listen close enough when water levels are low
- Run of the river hydro plant
 - Run is 5 miles
 - Run water off the creek into the plant
 - By time gets to generator, water is 700psi
- Generators can create 20 mega watts of energy each
 - Has two generators
- Goal is to get as much energy from stream of water they can
- Max output 37MW
 - Household consumptions is 1.5kw
 - Can power approx. 24,600 homes
 - Creston consumes approx. 4MW for all 2,670 dwellings for Creston
- Plant is privately owned. Toleshouse Energy Group
 - Took 3 years to get approval and plant built
- Currently offline as flow is so low
- Sell power to Brookfield Renewable Energy
 - Most goes to LA
