- 1) Go to my.rotary.org and log in.
- 2) On the top right of the screen click the down arrow next to your name.
- 3) Go to the “My Donations” in the drop-down menu choices.
- 4) Click the top hyperlink in light blue called “Donor History Report”.
- 5) Click open the Donor History Report.
- 6) Your giving history will open. If you go to the bottom left of the screen you will see two tabs. One says “Overview” and the other is “Transaction Detail”. Transaction Details gives you details of your donations by year and by fund, e.g., Annual Fund, Polio, etc.

Last Week's Speaker Sheila Hart Enchanted Us With Travel Tales from Brazil



Travelling with Rotary opens up many doors and relationships that one would not otherwise experience. This was reflected in the lively post presentation discussion by several Daybreakers who have had the opportunity to experience Brazil whether through Rotary Youth Exchange, Rotary Friendship Exchange or through the International Travel and Hosting Fellowship of Rotary. All who have had the opportunity to visit Iguazu Falls reflected that it was like Niagara Falls on steroids. Iguazu located at the junction of Brazil, Argentina and Paraguay extends over 2700 meters. A visit to Manaus on the Amazon would not be complete without a visit to the magnificent opera house, Theatre Amazonas. Rio de Janeiro, with its iconic Copacabana Beach is a must see for all visitors. A visit to Paraty, founded in 1597, is so unique with its cobblestone-paved streets made from rocks used as ballast in boats from Portugal when the vessels came to convey supplies and reap the rewards from gold mining in the mountains beyond the port.
