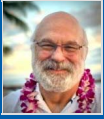

Wednesday, March 29, 2023



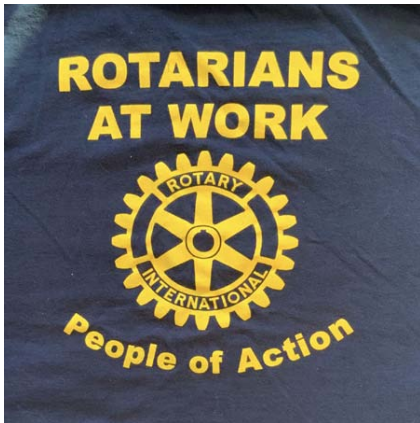
