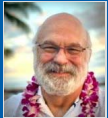

Uganda trip planned for 2023

Friends,

Just wanted to let you know that we are organizing a group to visit Uganda in late January 2023. We will arrive in Entebbe on or before 28 JAN, and proceed to eastern Uganda (Tororo District) on 29 JAN.

We will build an itinerary that is designed around Anthill Foundation and Rotary projects in education, water, and community assessment, depending in part on your interests.

We will also have a medical team going. The medical volunteers will work in clinics with the Rural Health Team. Some choose to spend only 10 days working with the medical team; others remain from 15-17 days (Recommended!).

I haven't checked airplane fares recently, but counting airfare and a couple of days of R&R at one of Uganda's wonderful national parks, the cost has not been more than \$3,000 for the full 17 days, counting airfare.
