PRESIDENT ROB'S PERSPECTIVE

November is The Rotary Foundation month. In a season of "giving thanks" for all our blessings, Rotary International encourages us to lift up our mission "to enable Rotarians to advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through the improvement of health, the support of education, and the alleviation of poverty." To belong to Rotary International and support **The Rotary Foundation**, a non-profit corporation, inspires, encourages, and empowers us to contribute and unite to take action whereby we create lasting change locally and globally. As such, I am reminded as a Rotarian, together we do things that are impossible for individuals.

To celebrate and participate in **The Rotary Foundation month** our club decided at its October 23, 2018 meeting to hold a **live auction on Tuesday, November 20** during our regular lunch meeting (before our Guest Speaker and Rotary Youth Exchange Rebound Student, Grant Anderson, talks about his year and experience in Taiwan). The auction proceeds will go toward our Club's annual pledge of \$5,000 to The Rotary Foundation. In return, our contribution helps us qualify for matching annual Rotary District 5100 Grants of at least \$2,000. The difference we make enables us to sustain our various local and global service projects, including: The White Salmon Head-Start Children's Books Literacy Program; the Holiday Giving Tree Program (in Partnership with WGAP), the Dictionary Project for Klickitat County Third Graders; The White Salmon-Bingen Annual Community Pride project (in Partnership with the Chamber of Commerce and other community partners), It Takes A Village (International awareness in our community celebration in partnership with the White Salmon Farmer's Market), and The Rotary Youth Exchange program for our in-bound, out-bound, and rebound students (that benefits more than just a few students, we build better friendships promote world peace).

While November highlights The Rotary Foundation, **our number one priority** continues to be **new members** and at the same time, recognizing the outstanding service of existing members, because you my fellow Rotarians are our club's most important asset and investment. So my question to you is: who do you know to have the heart of a Rotarian in "service above self," that you can invite to lunch or join us in a service projects to see and hear who we are with the action and difference we make?

Speaking of members, our **Annual Rotary Club Holiday Party** is set for **Tuesday, December 4 beginning at 5:30 pm at the Skyline Community Center**, catered by Beneventi's. This year our club's P-Team wants to recognize and give thanks to some of our past Rotarians and our current Rotary Youth Exchange host families. The Club voted that Rotarians will not be charged an addition meal fee, but that club members will be assessed \$30.00 per person for our immediate family members and / or significant who attend.
