### PRESIDENT ROB'S PERSPECTIVE

**April** was one of the busiest months we as **ROTARIANS** have participated in **Community Service**. Every Rotary Year, **RI Club Presidents are required** to set goals for their club (that can be changed as necessary), but are expected to be posted on **Rotary Club Central**, to track various aspects of each club, including service projects and the number of Club members participating in these service projects.

**Community Service is the second of five Avenues of Service**, and you, our Club members beat the expectations and goals I set last November for our two projects: **HWY 141 & Community Roads Spring Cleanup (Tue. Apr 23** – Chris Samuels, chair), and the **24<sup>th</sup> Annual COMMUNITY PRIDE (Fri. Apr 26 & Sat Apr. 27** – Susan Baker, chair). I estimated and set goals that we would have 21 of our 38 Club members help with the with these two service projects; when we actually had 27 of our 38 Club members. **Inspirational!**

Furthermore, I set a goal of 9 Club members (last November) to attend the annual **District Training Assembly** on **Sat. Apr 13** (based on our attendance at **DTA** in 2018). Our actual number of members who participated in leadership development this year was 11, the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest delegation of Rotarians from a Club. Again, **inspirational!**

When our 16 Club members set a **VISION** for our Club (at the **Sat. Mar. 23<sup>rd</sup> 4-hour VISION Workshop**) over the next five years to have at least 25% of our Club members attend the annual District Training Assembly, who would have imagined that we have actually begun to exceed this goal at a level of 27%! **Inspirational!**

So, where do we go from here as “Rotarians, being People of **ACTION?**” **May, ROTARY INTERNATIONAL focuses on our Fifth Avenue of Service, Youth Services**. One way to celebrate, participate, and support our **RYE students** is to attend the annual **District 5100 Conference** at the River House Resort in Bend, OR (**Fri. May 17 – Sun. May 19**). At this event, we will celebrate and support our **2019-2020 Rotary Youth Exchange Out-Bound Students, Erica, Margo, Jasper, and Olivia**. At this event, in addition to sharing fellowship with fellow Rotarians we have met from other Clubs while attending PETS and DTA we will give thanks to our many District leaders and committee chairs and members (like the **Rotary Youth Exchange Service Committee**) who have served us well this past Rotary Year
