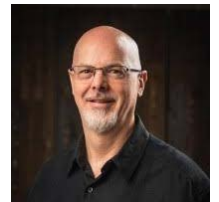


Oct. 18 -- Program: Fr. Sibi Poulouse from St. Edward the Martyr in Sisters

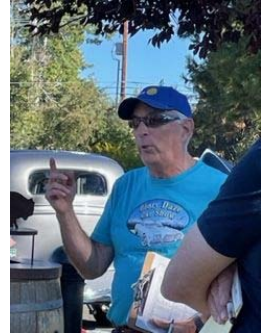
Club Assists "Rockin" Car Show
